


MAIN FEATURES (APRIL 2025)

2. New navigation




3. Advanced Search

All searches:

- cover both **ccb.belgium.be** and **atwork.safeonweb.be**
- are anti-chronological (last items show up first)
- can be **narrowed** down (for **articles**) in **types** and **subjects** (tags).
